REGULAR MEETING

January 4, 2024

The Town Council of the Town of Kentwood, Louisiana held its regular session on Thursday, January 4, 2024 at 6:00 P.M., at the Kentwood City Hall with Mayor Irma T. Gordon presiding. Mayor Gordon called the meeting to order following opening prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

The roll was called with the following results:

A motion was offered by Councilman Hall, second by Councilman Stewart and unanimously carried to approve minutes of December's meeting.

A motion was offered by Councilman Diamond, second by Councilman Hall and unanimously carried to set the prices for Public Records Request Fees to \$2 per page. That applies to hard copies and digital copies.

A motion was offered by Councilman Stewart, second by Councilman Hall and unanimously carried to approve the Agreed Upon Procedures.

A motion was offered by Councilman Diamond, second by Councilwoman Wilkerson and unanimously carried to approve the Beer and Liquor License for Wine on Main, LLC.

A motion was offered by Councilman Hall, second by Councilman Stewart and unanimously carried to table the approval of the Council meeting dates for 2024 until February 2024's meeting.

A motion was offered by Councilman Diamond, second by Councilwoman Wilkerson and unanimously carried to authorize Mayor Gordon to enter into a contract with Tangipahoa Parish Animal Control and sign documents on behalf of the Town of Kentwood.

A motion was offered by Councilman Callihan, second by Councilwoman Wilkerson and unanimously carried to accept the resignation of Bret Cutrer as a patrolman, effective 12/29/2023.

Mayor Gordon selected a committee to look at and update the Employee Handbook and Policies. She selected Mrs. Audrey Winters, Mr. William Lawson, the clerks, along with herself and the Town Attorney.
